What is Communities in Teams?

Helping communities do more

A sense of belonging to a community is a fundamental human need

This is more relevant in this moment than ever before



Pain Points for AYSO Members





Keeping track of many apps is inefficient and tiring



Reliable Reach

It's tough to reach members without nagging



Organized Information

It's easy to lose track of files and important documents



Privacy

It's difficult to place guardrails around sensitive information

Teams Brings Communities Together

Run your group securely and safely for free with no advertisements





Easy Sign Up

Phone number or emailbased sign up with privacy to hide email ID/phone number in the community



Messaging

Post messages, share photos/videos to a community activity feed and reply to those posts on a thread



Productivity

Organize & Manage members with polls, sign-up sheets, to-do lists, and much more



Meetings

Host **unlimited time** community meetings and up-to 100 meeting participants



Events

Host, co-ordinate and publish events either in –person/hybrid/ live and view them in personal calendars



Safety

Automated image scanning and remove bad actors/delete posts all backed by Microsoft data and privacy.


How to use Teams as Regional Commissioner

- Create a Community for your region.
- Join a group for your Area or to get updates from AYSO.
- Connect with Coaches, Referees, and volunteers
- Share announcements, photos, videos, links, and files
- Schedule events to keep everyone up to date.
- Keep content in one place season over season.
- Add other members as owners to managed and moderate the group.


How to use Teams as a coach



On Windows 11 Desktop




- 1. On Windows 11 desktop, go to the search bar and type "Microsoft Teams"

Difference between work and life, mobile


Work Account
